POINT COMFORT—Steve Marwitz has joined the environmental protection department at Formosa Plastics in Point Comfort. Marwitz will monitor the impacts of the plant's discharges into local bays and estuaries and make recommendations to Formosa for enhancing the marine ecosystem.

Prior to joining Formosa, Marwitz was with the Coastal Fisheries Branch of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department at Port O'Connor and Rockport.

He was the resident marine biologist at the Port O'Connor station where he was in charge of monitoring Matagorda and San Antonio bays.

Marwitz's last assignment with Coastal Fisheries in Rockport was analyzing fishery data for the entire coast.

A graduate of Texas A & M University, Marwitz holds a bachelor of science degree

in marine biology and has published a number of papers
